Purpose: This intensive Audio course is a practical module on Sound Engineering with adequate theoretical understanding. *The learners are introduced to the techniques in multi-track recording, mixing, and mastering.* Training and sufficient hands-on experience are imparted in a Professional Digital Studio set-up. The course will cover studio acoustics and impart professional expertise in designing both home and professional audio recording studios.

Content: Sound Engineering: Physical and Perceptual Aspects of Sound, Studio Acoustics, Analogue and Digital Primer, Hardware and Software Integration, Audio Interface, Recording Techniques, Microphone Techniques, Equalization, Compressors, Limiters, use of Outboard gears (External Hardware Applications),

Recording Software, use of Effects Plug-ins and the Mastering Process. **Introduction to Music Arrangement:** VST based Music Arrangement using computer applications (Learner must have the knowledge of music and the ability to play Electronic Keyboard or Piano).

Instructions to Reach Ishvani Kendra:

Ishvani Kendra is about 7.5 kms from the Pune Railway station and 4 kms from the Pune Airport.

From any location in the city, you may engage OLA/UBER taxi or auto and enter 'Destination' as 'Ishvani Kendra, Pune.' And automatically, you will see the additional information below it as **Opposite to Novotel Ramwadi...or Ramwadi Vadgaon Sheri, Pune...** You can choose either of these two locations and the driver will bring you directly to our institute. But if you are taking an ordinary auto, please give direction to the driver as Ishvani Kendra at Sainikwadi on Vadgaonsheri Road and follow the directions given below.

To arrive at IK from the railway station or city: (i) take Nagar Road and at Ramwadi, opposite to Novotel Hotel, (ii) take Vadgaonsheri Road. After 700 meters on your right is **Christ the King Church in Sainikwadi**. Adjacent to it, (iii) take the private road with a gate painted in yellow colour that has the signboard, ISHVANI KENDRA, for further 200 meters.

The normal metered Auto fare from the Pune Railway Station or Airport to Ishvani Kendra should not exceed ₹ 160/-.
